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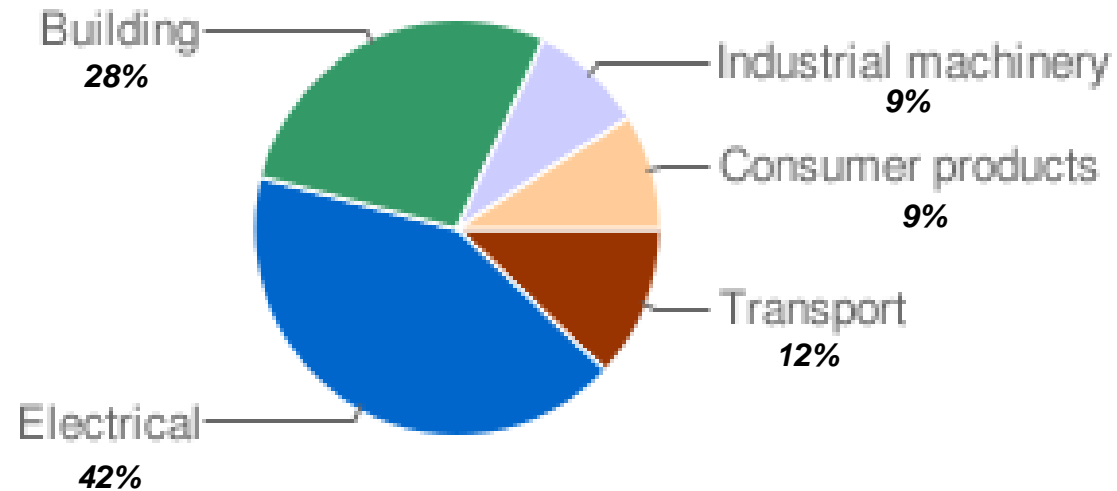

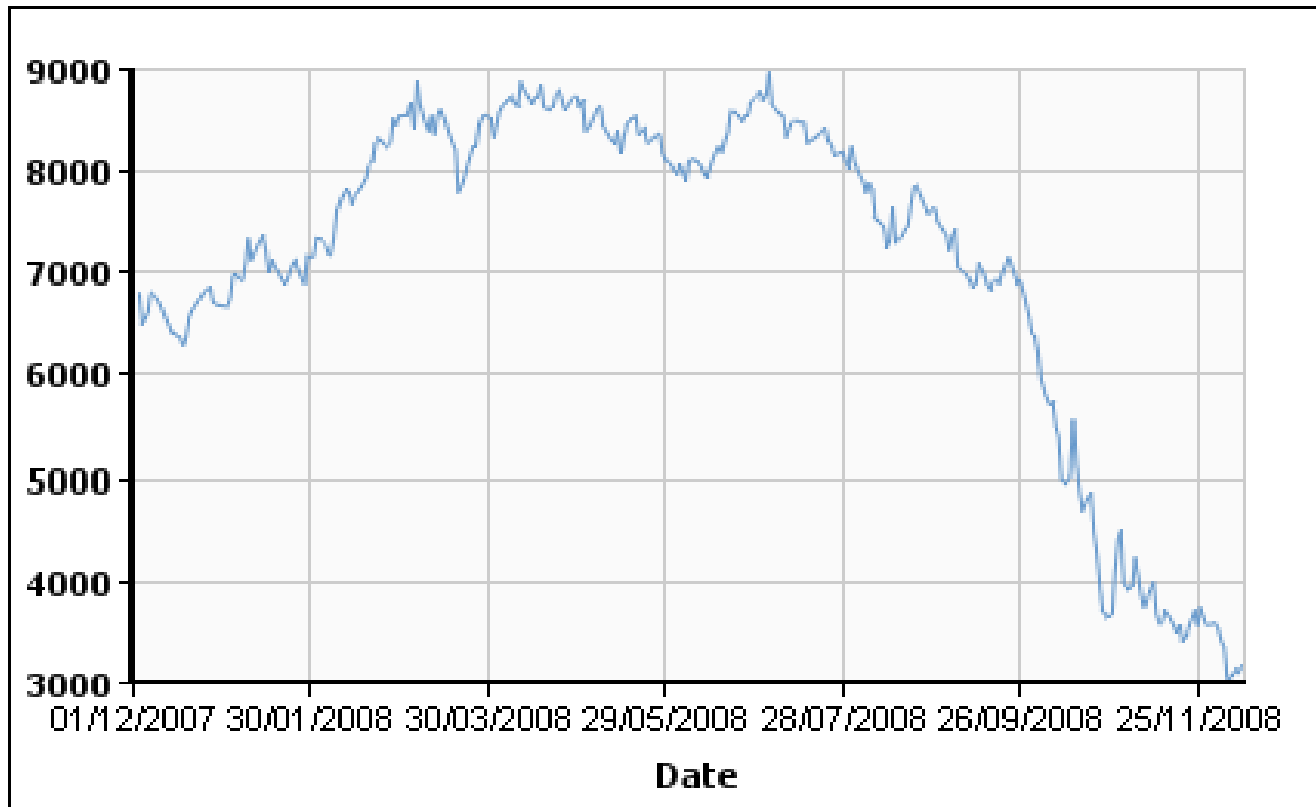

- The cash market for copper has decreased from approximately \$9,000 per tonne to \$3,100 tonne in the last year due to weaker demand and economic fears.
- The forward cash market is now trading at approximately \$3,400 per tonne. The market is currently indicating a bottom.
- A return to previous highs suggest a potential return of close to 200% in the commodity.



## Richmond Minerals: Leverage to Copper

- Richmond Minerals (“Richmond”) is a mining exploration company focused on developing major copper resources across Quebec.
- Richmond’s land ownership, technical expertise and access to infrastructure all assist in placing the firm in a major leverage position as copper prices move upward.
- Richmond also owns properties which have demonstrated a potential Uranium resource.



## Richmond Minerals: Leverage to Copper

**Bondy Gneiss Project** – On November 17, 2008 Richmond announced results of recent grab samples showing returned values up to 4% copper and 21 grams per tonne silver, with an average of 3.2% copper and 17 grams per tonne silver. Richmond is in the process of retaining a diamond-drilling contractor and will initiate a drill program at the Bondy Gneiss in early 2009.



**Grenville Property** – Richmond has entered into a JV agreement with Fort Chimo Minerals to develop the property. The project consists of 31 separate exploration properties covering 220,000 acres of mineral rights.

**Halle Property** – The Halle Property is located 20km east of Belleterre, Quebec. Airborne geophysical surveying identified two extremely conductive, multi channel electromagnetic with coincidental magnetic anomalies.



**Ste Anne du Lac Property** – The project consists of more than 150 claims and lies within the Cabonga-Mont Laurier radioactive district of the Grenville Geological Province. The project lies immediately to the west of Strateco's MontLaurier uranium project and southwest of Nova Uranium's property, which hosts several uranium showings.

Certain aspects of the geological setting of the Mont Laurier area are similar to the deposit rich geology of the Athabaska Basin in Saskatchewan.
